and a no-blame culture. Guidance is given on how to improve the airport infrastructure, both in terms of pavements and facilities such as lighting, signs and markings. The need to improve existing facilities before necessarily constructing new ones is especially highlighted. The subject of Rapid Exit Taxiways (RETs), their design, location and use, is treated in detail as is the importance of traffic mix and scheduling scheduling.

Land-side issues and environmental aspects are also addressed at the end of the Volume.
